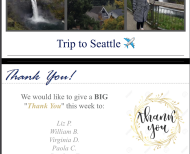
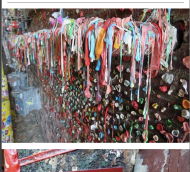
A Royal Tragedy: Examining Diana's Estate 25 Years Later
